Antifreeze	Antifreeze is considered Hazardous Waste and must be disposed of at one of the three Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection events. Dates for 2019 are May 18 and September 28 on Main Street in St. Johnsbury. St. Johnsbury residents can also bring Hazardous Waste to the collection events in Burke on July 20 and October 19.

Gas, Oil, Mixed	These are hazardous waste and must be brought to a seasonal Household Hazardous Waste Collection event. Dates for 2019 are May 18 and September 28 on Main Street in St. Johnsbury. St. Johnsbury residents can also bring Hazardous Waste to the collection events in Burke on July 20 and October 19.		
Glass bottles	All-in-1 recycling. Rinse clean, put cap back on if you have it, put in recycling.		
Hazardous Product Containers	Never mix bits of leftover hazardous material. Don't rinse out empty containers. If not entirely empty, bring to Household Hazardous Waste Collection event. Musical Instruments	Donate if in good condition, annual sale in Montpelier <a href="http://www.sharethemusicvt.org">www.sharethemusicvt.org</a>		
Newspaper	Use instead of wrapping paper, Shred and add to back yard compost or use for sheet mulching. Newspapers can also go in with recycling.		
Oil Filters	Dry out and dispose of in the trash		
Oil-Based Paints	Return for recycling to Paint Care collection locations: Sherwin Williams, Portland St., Aubuchon Hardware, Memorial Drive

Packing Materials	Post on Front Porch Forum, otherwise, packing peanuts are trash, pop air pillows and dispose of in the trash

Pesticides	These harmful chemicals must be disposed of at a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event. Dates for 2019 are May 18 and September 28 on Main Street in St. Johnsbury. St. Johnsbury residents can also bring Hazardous Waste to the collection events in Burke on July 20 and October 19.		
Pharmaceuticals	These can be disposed of in a drop box at the St. Johnsbury Police Department, Main St., St. Johnsbury		
Phone Books	All-in-1 recycling		
Pill Bottles	Unless 2" on two sides, these are not recyclable in the All-in-1 system.		
Pizza Boxes	If free of food debris, these can be recycled in the All-in-1 system.		
Plastic Bottles/Jugs	All-in-1 Recycling		
Plastic Bags	Plastic bags, such as shopping bags, produce bags, plastic wrap that covers toilet paper, paper towels, or cases of water bottles, can be recycled in collection bins at the entrance of Price Chopper, Memorial Drive, St. Johnsbury.		
Print Cartridges	Recycle with the manufacturer, or at point of purchase		
Propane Tanks	Tanks without a valve can be brought to the scrap metal collection bin at St. Johnsbury Transfer Station		
Rags, Clean	Save for reuse

Railroad Ties	St. Johnsbury Transfer Station - Construction and Demolition		
Receipts	Ball up paper receipts and put in All-in-1		
Refrigerator	St. Johnsbury Transfer Station - \$25.00		
Sheetrock	If usable, donate, or list on Front Porch Forum, otherwise, dispose of at the St. Johnsbury Transfer Station - Construction and Demolition		
Shingles, Asphalt	St. Johnsbury Transfer Station - Construction and Demolition		
Shoes	If in good, usable condition, donate to the Salvation Army (Railroad St.), or The Little Thrift Shop at the North Church (Main St.)		
Smoke Detectors	Banned from the landfill; smoke detectors contain small amounts of a radioactive material – poses little threat but becomes a hazard if broken open. Curie Services offers a mail-back kit for a fee.		
Styrofoam	trash, St. Johnsbury Transfer Station		
Toaster	Dispose of this item at the St. Johnsbury Transfer Station.		
Televisions	Televisions are banned from landfill disposal. Dispose of Televisions in the E-waste bin at the St. Johnsbury Transfer Station at no charge.		
Textiles	Donate clothing that is in good usable condition at the Salvation Army (Railroad St.), or The Little Thrift Shop at the North Church (Main St.)		
Thermometers, Mercury	Store in a safe place until the next Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day. Dates for 2019 are May 18 and September 28 on Main Street in St. Johnsbury. St. Johnsbury residents can also bring Hazardous Waste to the collection events in Burke on July 20 and October 19.		
Thermostats	Household Hazardous Waste Collection event, or bring to Aubuchon for recycling
