DESCRIPTION:

The Scholarship shall be awarded annually to a student who plans to attend full time in a college or university accredited by the appropriate regional accrediting association and listed as such in American Universities and Colleges, published by the American Council on Education, 1 Du Pont Circle, Washington DC, 20036; and to pursue at such institution a course of study leading to an Associate's, Bachelor's, or equivalent degree for fire, EMS, or criminal justice. It is hoped that the scholarship is to be applied to room, board, tuition, books, laboratory, and similar fees for students and shall be paid by the donor directly to the student. There shall be a minimum of one (1) \$1000.00 scholarship awarded at the end of the student's first college year.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, the student must have a strong interest in emergency service, maintain a "C" or better average, and be a graduate of one of the following schools: St. Johnsbury Academy, Lyndon Institute, Manchester/Essex Regional High School, Union Baptist School, Littleton NH High School, Concord High School, Danville High School, North Shore Technical High School, and be desirous of attending college. Other factors that the donor will consider in selecting the recipients of the scholarship award include extracurricular activities, community service, and sports activities. Other requirements are included in the application. Determination of awards will be determined by these requirements.

DEADLINES:

The St. Johnsbury Firefighters Association, International Association Of Firefighters L-2934/Gene McDonough Scholarship Fund Trustees will accept only mailed applications from March 15th until May 1st, of each academic year. All applications **MUST** be postmarked by May 1st of each calendar year and to be clearly marked, **Gene McDonough Scholarship Application** on the envelope. The successful recipient(s) will be announced by June 1st, and a formal announcement will be made at the annual memorial service in September.
