Regular Selectboard Meeting

Meeting was opened at 7:00PM

Minutes of the May 27<sup>th</sup> meeting was approved on a motion by J. Moore and Ruggles.

Warrants were approved on a motion by Ruggles and T. Moore.

A catering license was approved for Blackbird Bar on a motion by Ruggles and J. Moore, Murphy abstained.

A liquor license for NEK Processing was approved on a motion by J. Moore and Ruggles, Murphy abstained.

Kingdom Tap Room was approved for serving liquor outside on a motion by Ruggles and J. Moore, Murphy abstained.

A public hearing was held at 7:20PM to explain and discuss a feasibility study that would focus on providing a safe and convenient route to allow pedestrian and bicycle access from the LVRT Trailhead and Three Rivers Recreation Trail parking area on South Main St to the downtown area. The study could cost between \$20,000 to \$35,000 and the town's share would be 10% of the cost.

On a motion by Murphy and J. Moore the board approved proceeding with the grant.

Abigail Freidman from VLCT explained the services the league could provide for recruiting a town manager.

On a motion by Ruggles and T. Moore the board approved the renewal of the line of credit with the Passumpsic Savings Bank that allows us to borrow to cover costs on the Westside North project. The town pays the bills then submits a copy to the state for reimbursement. The interest rate is .86%.

The board decided to delay the discussion of the 2014 Water and Sewer budgets and devote a special meeting for that purpose. A special Selectboard meeting will be warned for Thursday June 12, 2014 at 5:00PM to discuss that budget.

On a motion by T. Moore and J. Moore the meeting was adjourned at 8:19PM.
